New York / Connecticut Shore

From South - Take 95 North to 395 North to Exit 91W-Route 6 West. Follow Route 6 to the intersection of Route 6 and Route 169. Go left (South) Route 169. PierceCare is located approximately one-quarter mile on your left, first two entrances for Pierce Memorial Baptist Nursing & Rehab Center, third entrance for Creamery Brook (Vina Lane).

Hartford

Take I-84 East to 384 East to Route 6 East to Brooklyn at the intersection of Route 6 and Route 169. Go right (South) Route 169. PierceCare is located approximately one-quarter mile on your left, first two entrances for Pierce Memorial Baptist Nursing & Rehab Center, third entrance for Creamery Brook (Vina Lane).

Providence

Take Route 6 West to Brooklyn; at the intersection of Route 6 and Route 169. Go left (South) Route 169. PierceCare is located approximately one-quarter mile on your left, first two entrances for Pierce Memorial Baptist Nursing & Rehab Center, third entrance for Creamery Brook (Vina Lane).
